

Online Giving Frequently Asked Questions

Q) Is it safe to give online?

A) Yes. Online giving can be safer than writing a check as electronic gifts cannot be lost or stolen.

Q) What type of bank accounts can I give from?

A) Checking or savings account.

Q) Are there fees associated with giving online?

A) You will not pay a fee with an online contribution.

Q) Can I use a credit card to contribute online?

A) Liberty Corner Presbyterian Church (LCPC) has decided not to allow contributions to be charged to a credit card. We do not want to put someone in the position of potentially going into debt and paying interest on gifts made to the church.

Q) Do I have an option to make a one-time or recurring gift?

A) The system will allow the option of making a one-time contribution or setting-up recurring contributions. For recurring gifts, you have the option of giving weekly, monthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually.

Q) Will I receive contribution statements from the church?

A) LCPC will continue to send contribution statements.

Q) How will I know if my contribution was set-up correctly or received?

A) You will receive an email immediately after setting-up/making your contribution.
