Thank you for your interest in the **Honduras 2010 Mission Trip!** The trip information package provides answers to the many of the questions you may have about the ministry.

The Registration form, Medical form and Financial Covenant are required for participation in the trip. You will find a link to the forms on the Hearts For Honduras webpage (www.hfhonduras.org). All three forms must be completed and returned with the non-refundable \$150 registration fee on or before Monday, **March 15, 2010**. Remember to keep copies for yourself. The trip can accommodate no more than 35 people per week. Enrollment will be on a first-come, first-serve basis for week of preference. Individuals may be asked to change weeks or be placed on a waiting list.

Age Requirement

Youth must be at least age 17 during 2010, must be entering 11th or 12th grade, and must be accompanied by a parent or volunteer guardian who assumes full responsibility for the youth during the trip. Parents traveling with their own child(ren) cannot serve as guardian for another youth. Both the parents and the guardian must sign a consent form. The number of high school aged youth is limited. The Honduras Vision Team reserves the right to approve all youth participants.
